Foundations

Monday–Friday

Foundations is a morning program that includes three key components: early literacy, pre-handwriting skills and play/social skills. The program is designed for children who will benefit from reinforcement in foundational skills for learning and preparing for kindergarten in September. It incorporates Handwriting Without Tears and the Nemours BrightStart! early literacy program, designed for children at risk for reading challenges.

Speech and Language Explorers

Monday–Friday

Speech and Language Explorers is a specialized, speech and language intensive program that provides support to children with speech difficulties. Taught by a speech language pathologist, this morning program provides intensive practice of speech targets provided through a variety of motivating and functional small group activities as well as through targeted daily individual speech therapy sessions. This program is supported by an occupational therapist and offers education and training for family members to facilitate carryover of skills.

Super K's

Monday/Wednesday/Friday

Super K's is an afternoon group for children who will be attending pre-K/kindergarten in September and need extra support in the areas of language, motor, sensory and social skills. Guided play and activity based projects will facilitate readiness and skill development for a successful year. Families will be invited to participate in learning opportunities with their children. This program is led by an Occupational Therapist and a Speech and Language Pathologist.

Playstars

Monday/Wednesday

Playstars is an afternoon group for children who need further development of language, play and social interaction skills. The small groups provide each child with individual attention and opportunities to develop and practice skills needed in order to be successful in a larger preschool program. This program is led by an Occupational Therapist and a Speech and Language Pathologist.

Monday–Friday, 4 or 6 week sessions

Summer Voyagers combines intensive, small group academic instruction in reading, math, language arts and written expression with social and recreational opportunities and executive function skill-building.
